We are pleased to announce the continuation of the in-person SIU Leadership Development Workshops for all Civil Service and Administrative/Professional staff—both union and non-union.

New this year: To accommodate your busy schedules, we split the previous full-day sessions into two half-day workshops.

Workshop Offerings

Six half-day workshops will be available, including a brand-new course:

- Time Management (new this year)
- The Roles of a Leader
- Unleash Initiative to Improve Your Work and Workplace
- Problem Solving & Decision Making (formerly combined with "Unleash" above)
- Empowerment & Delegation
- Motivation & Leading Without a Title (formerly combined with "Empowerment" above)

Each session will include interactive learning through small group, large group, and individual activities. The content is designed to be practical, engaging, and applicable to all staff roles.

Over the past three years, more than 1,200 staff members across Carbondale, Edwardsville, Springfield, and Alton attended these workshops, rating them an impressive 4.9 out of 5. Attendees represented a wide range of departments, roles, and experience levels.

The facilitator will again be Dr. Dave Heth, an SIU retiree with decades of leadership and training experience in higher education, industry, and the nonprofit sector.

Separate workshops will be offered at 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. on each date.
